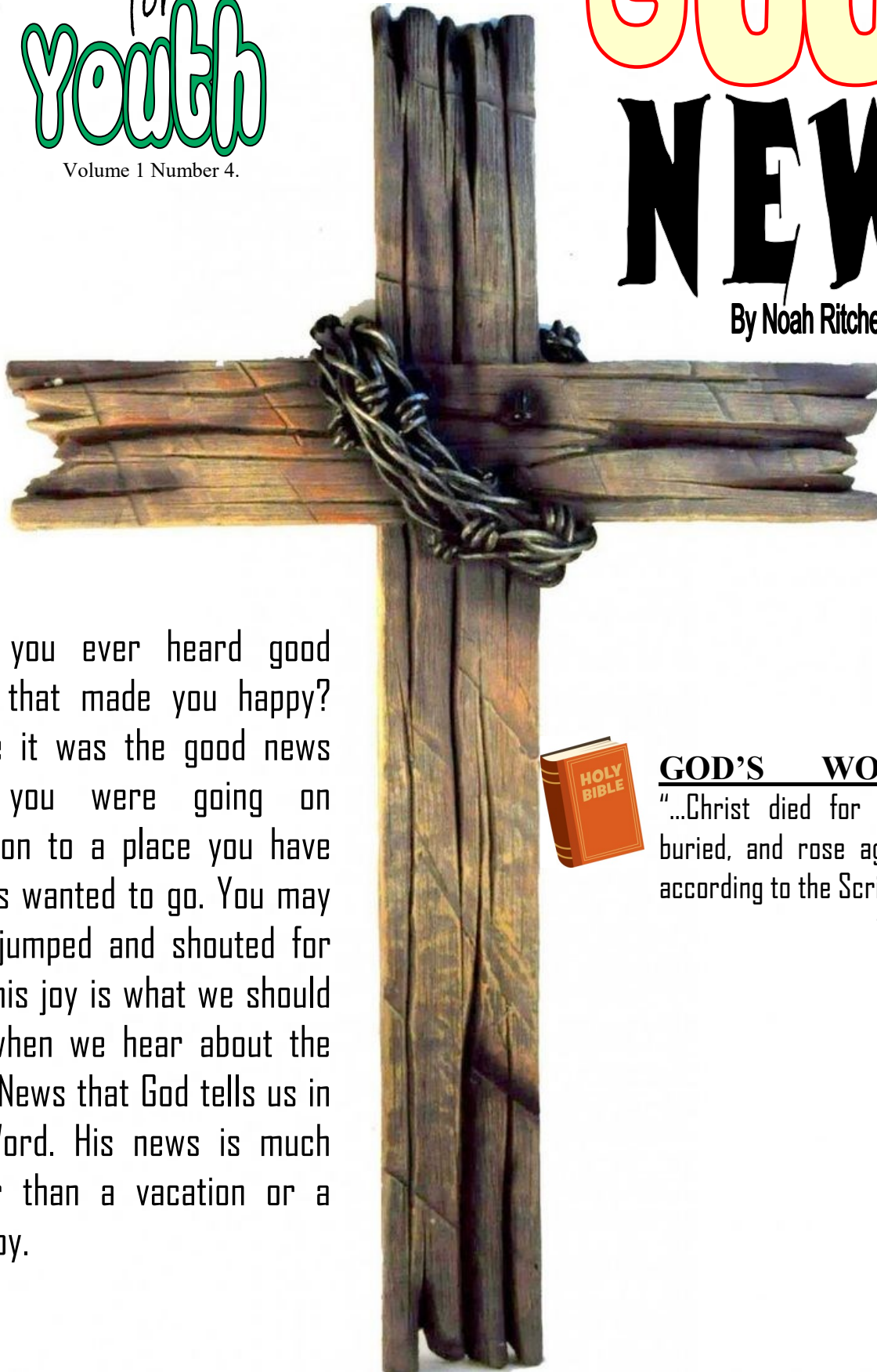

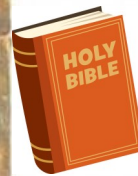

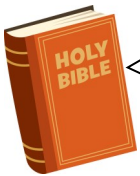


The Good News

1 Corinthians 15:20

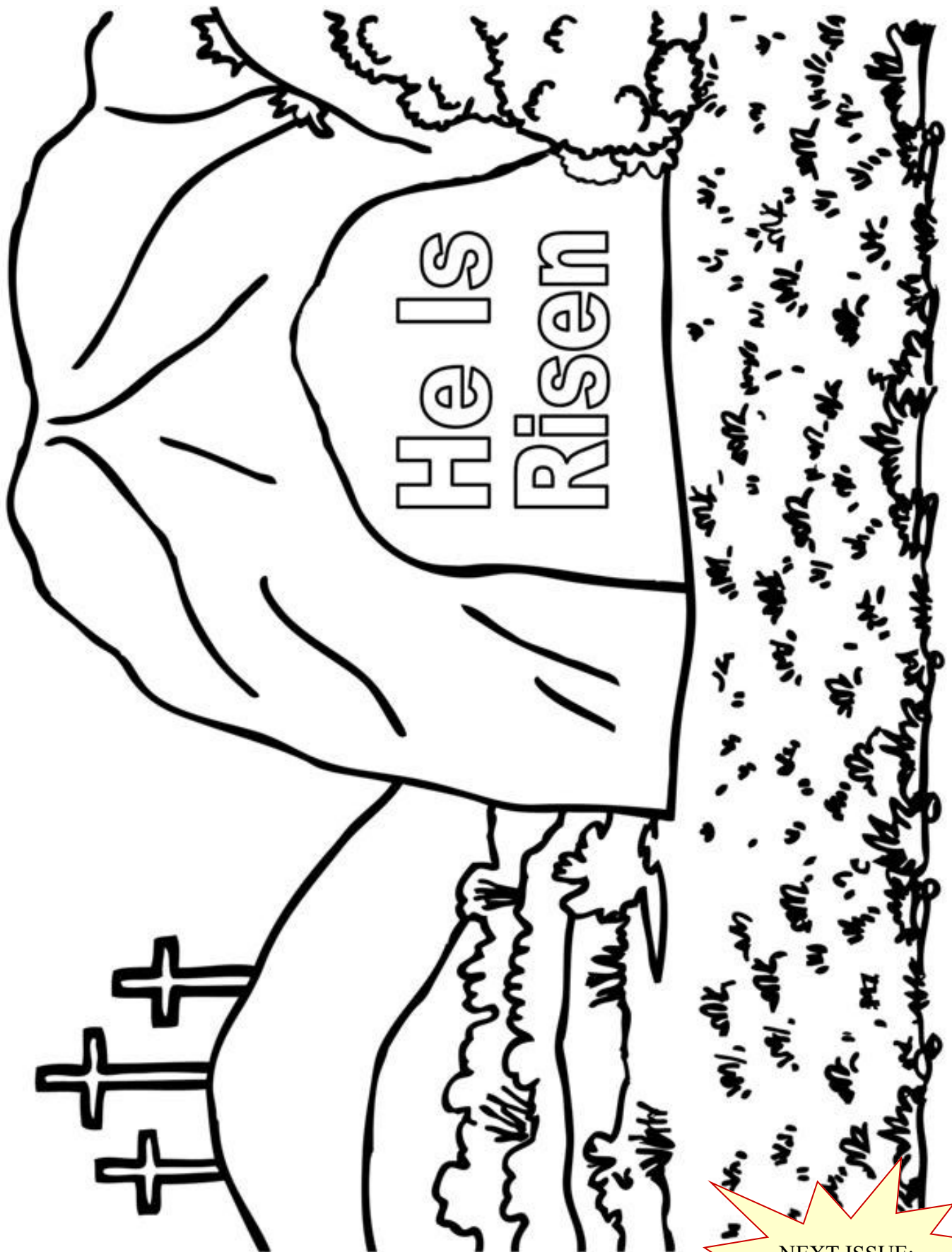
