

# Candy Cane

There are many ways to share Christ with our friends and family during Christmas time. One of those ways is the candy cane. Today, candy canes come in all sorts of colors and flavors, but the original white and red candy cane can be used to tell the story about the Savior.

**“J” for Jesus** – Hold the candy cane upside-down and it makes a “J” that we can use to tell people about Jesus Christ. That He came to earth to be born in a manger, go to the cross for our sins, and rise again on the third day.

**Shepherd’s Staff** – Hold the candy cane the usual way and it looks like a staff a shepherd would use. Just like a shepherd provides for the sheep, Jesus Christ provided salvation for us.

**Red Stripes** – The red stripes remind us that Jesus Christ paid the price for our sins by shedding His blood on the cross.

**White Stripes** – The white stripes remind us that when we trust in Jesus Christ we are made completely forgiven and righteous in Him.
